President's Message

Rob's '36 Chevy Romo Auto Wrecking

In last month's president's message, I wrote about my dad's service station, which was located at Cedar and Church Avenues in the community of Calwa. Sometime around 1960, a shopping center was built across Cedar Avenue from my Dad's property. In this shopping center was a liquor store operated by Luke Genco. Luke had a son, Rob, who was about my age. Rob and I came to be good friends.

We were both fascinated by the automobile and spent many an hour building model cars and building and racing slot cars. Sometime around 1968 or 1969, when we were both in junior high, a guy, down on his luck, came around the area trying to sell a 1936 Chevy sedan. He first approached my dad, who was not interested. He eventually found his way to Genco's Liquors. Luke thought that this might be something his son would enjoy tinkering with, so he purchased the car for the sum of \$100. This would be my first foray into automobile restoration.

The Chevy was in running condition and the body was fairly straight with little or no rust, as I recall. The interior was in ragged condition, and nearly every mechanical component on the car needed rebuilding. I helped Rob work on the car a few times and I recall helping remove the engine from the car so it could be sent out for rebuilding.

We also made numerous trips to Romo Auto Wrecking on Motel Drive (now called Golden State Boulevard) between Ashlan and Shaw Avenues. I think Rob's dad knew the owner, so we were able to roam about the place as we desired. Rob's mom would drop us off (we were still too young to have a drivers license) and we would spend the afternoon locating and removing the parts that Rob needed. This being the late 1960's, there were numerous cars from the thirties and forties in the wrecking yard. We also went to a few swap meets at the Fresno Fairgrounds.

We eventually got the old Chevy mechanically road worthy, although I do not recall that any body or upholstery work were ever done. I remember that the engine and engine compartment sparkled when Rob was done with it. I think he redid the dashboard also. Rob never did drive the car much. It sat in his parent's garage through most of high school and college. He eventually moved the Chevy to his home in another city. I have not had any contact with my friend in a number of years, but I would be surprised if he still has it.

I hope to see all of you at the June meeting.


